Although athletics have a long history that extends back thousands of years, many of the organized sports we know and love today were developed in the last few hundreds years. The history of sport is undeniably vast, there are some key points over time that have made a significant impact on the development of these activities. Let's take a closer look at how popular sports have been practiced around the world and the detailed language that's been developed to describe them.

All About Sports Betting

Unlike with American odds, the decimal odds number equals the amount a bettor wins for every \$1 wagered. For decimal odds, the number signifies the total payout, rather than the profit. Basically, your wager (or stake) is already included in the decimal number (no need to add back your wager), which makes it much easier to calculate your total payout.

In many cases, especially in good matchups, point spreads, and over/unders, both sides of a bet will be listed with negative odds. When betting on a player, team, prop, spread, or over/under with negative odds, you usually risk more than you will profit.

In the above example, if you bet \$100 on McIlroy to win, you could make \$800 profit ($\$100 \times (8/1)$) and get back your initial stake of \$100, resulting in a total payout of \$900. If you wager \$100 on Scheffler to win, you could receive a profit of \$1,000 ($\$100 \times (10/1)$) in addition to the \$100 initial stake, leading to a total payout of \$1,100. The potential profit for a Cam Smith win would be even higher because you could make a profit of \$1,200 ($\$100 \times (12/1)$). With the initial stake of \$100 returned, it would result in a total payout of \$1,300.

First-time bettors always get burned by the spread early on. Handicappers make fine careers setting spreads, so it stands to reason that they know more about odds and trends than most novice gamblers. Learning how to read, interpret, and react to spreads are all vital parts of a bettor's journey.
